How Does Belief In The Christian God Change How We Live?

What do we believe about God?

<u>Transcendent</u>- not bound by time or space

Infinite- that means he cannot grow more

Eternal- his existence is without beginning or end

Immutable- never changes

Omnipotent- all powerful

Omnipresent- present everywhere

Omniscient- all knowing

Absolute Goodness- He is totally holy.

Personal & Loving- He desires a relationship with us

What evidence is there for the Christian God?

The Cosmological Argument evidence:

- Anything that begins to exist has a cause.
- The universe (including matter, energy, space, and time) began to exist.
- Therefore, the universe has a cause.

Evidence from the design of the universe- the Teleological Argument for God Moral argument:

- If objective moral values exist, God must exist.
- · Objective moral values exist.
- Therefore, God must exist.

So What? What difference does it make that God Exists?

No God, no design

No God, no value

No God, no ultimate purpose or direction for your life

No God, no meaning

No God, no morals

No God, no future

How does belief in the Christian God change the way we live?

- 1. If God is holy, absolute goodness, then we can adopt his moral code as our own and live out his moral character
 - Exodus 20:1-17
 - Galatians 5:22-23

- 2. If God is omnipresent and there is nowhere to escape his presence... then he, by definition, shows up everywhere, in culture, in life. We can live in expectation of his showing up... anywhere.
 - Acts 17:16 and following
- 3. If God is the designer and has given value, meaning and purpose to all of life, then we can discover and live out our God-given purposes.
 - Psalm 139
- 4. If God desires a loving relationship with each of us, his creation, then we can make the choice to accept his love and live in relationship with him every day. And since his character never changes, I can trust his love no matter what.

Ephesians 1: 3-5

"All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing...
